It's just a short ride to the **Broadway Palm Dinner Theater** for our Christmas night entertainment: **ELF, The Musical!** Prior to the show, a delicious **dinner buffet** is yours to enjoy. The Broadway Palm will have a wonderful holiday spread from salads to hand-carved meat, their famous desserts and everything in

between. You'll be entertained with beautiful singing, breathtaking dancing, festive costumes as this story unfolds. Day Two – Our day begins with the delicious Drury Inn buffet breakfast. Then, at the end of our day, evening beverages and the **FREE 5:30 KICKBACK** from 5:30 – 7:00 PM. To this day, you can see the ceremonial shell mounds left behind by the Calusa. **Sanibel** is a barrier island and is a very popular tourist destination known for its shell beaches and wildlife refuges. More than half of the island is made up of a wildlife refuge, the largest being J.N. “Ding” Darling National Wildlife Refuge. After lunch, we’ll have a narrated tram tour of J.N. “Ding” Darling Wildlife Refuge. The refuge covers more than 6,500 acres of land and strives to ensure that these lands are preserved, restored and maintained as a haven for wildlife. As a result, over 220 species of birds and other native animals make this refuge their home. In their effort to protect the wildlife, the park is closed to human visitors on Friday’s to give the animals the opportunity to exist in their natural state. During our visit to Sanibel we will enjoy an included midday meal at **George & Wendy’s** – a Sanibel favorite! After today’s Island adventure, we return to our Drury Inn in time for the **5:30 Kickback** We will call this our “Drury Dinner”. A great time to relax and get to know your fellow travelers.



Day Three – This morning, the breakfast buffet is again included in the hotel lobby. We’ll have a leisurely morning with a mid-morning departure. Our day continues with holiday festivities as we stop in Sarasota for the perfect end to our holiday vacation – a midday **dinner at Der Dutchman Amish Restaurant**. This restaurant is really a destination you’ll want to visit again and again. Our visit today will include a delicious buffet-style meal featuring ham or turkey, roast beef & “broasted” chicken with all the great home-style fixings. We will spend a little time here as you’ll want to browse the unique gift shop areas and bakery.
