**Atlanta**, Capital of Georgia. It lies in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains in the northwestern part of the state, just southeast of the Chattahoochee River. Atlanta is Georgia's **largest city** and the principal trade and transportation center of the southeastern United States. It is the center of an extensive metropolitan area that includes 20 counties and cities such as Decatur, East Point, and Marietta. **Atlanta** owes its existence to the railroads, the routes of which were determined by geography. Lying as it does at the southern extremity of the Appalachian Mountains, it became the gateway through which most overland traffic had to pass between the southern Atlantic Seaboard and regions to the west. In 1837 a spot near what is now Five Points, in the center of the present-day city, was selected for the southern terminus of a railroad that was subsequently built northward to Chattanooga, Tennessee. The location was known first as **Terminus** and then as **Marthasville**; in 1845 it was renamed **Atlanta** for the Western and Atlantic Railroad. Several other rail lines had converged on the city by 1860. The Civil war saw much of Atlanta Burned to the ground making Atlanta one of the South's most modern cities since it's rebirth!

**Day One** – On our first day of touring, we travel to **Atlanta** where we will enjoy a 3-night stay at **Drury Inn Morrow** with evening food & drinks. **Reasons to visit Georgia Aquarium in Atlanta**

- Atlanta's aquarium is home to tens of thousands of animals including 500 species from around the world and more than 60 habitats.
- The aquarium features a number of exhibits that are sure to reel you in such as Cold Water Quest, Ocean Voyager, River Scout, Aquanaut Adventure and Tropical Diver.
- The largest exhibit at Georgia Aquarium measures 284 feet long x 126 feet wide x 30 feet deep at the maximum depth. It holds 6.3 million gallons of water and is home to **whale sharks**, manta rays and more swimmers.
- The second largest exhibit holds 800,000 gallons of water and is home to six beluga whales.
- And you won't want to miss the dolphins exhibit and dolphin show at Georgia Aquarium featuring an expansive underwater dolphin viewing window and a spectacular musical theatrical performance that highlights the emotional bond shared between dolphins and humans.

After a thrilling day of exploring the city and oceans we'll get back to our Drury Inn in time for Cocktails and our Drury Dinner.

After our Drury Dinner we will offer a "Field Trip" to explore Downtown Atlanta and enjoy the city lights with a stop at the Atlanta Marriott Marquis, a breathtaking hotel with an awe-inspiring lobby that has been featured in many films and TV shows!
