# 15 DAYS TO SLOW THE SPREAD

Listen to and follow the directions of your **STATE AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES**.

**IF YOU FEEL SICK**, stay home. Do not go to work. Contact your medical provider.

**IF YOUR CHILDREN ARE SICK**, keep them at home. Do not send them to school. Contact your medical provider.

**IF SOMEONE IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD HAS TESTED POSITIVE** for the coronavirus, keep the entire household at home. Do not go to work. Do not go to school. Contact your medical provider.

**IF YOU ARE AN OLDER PERSON**, stay home and away from other people.

**IF YOU ARE A PERSON WITH A SERIOUS UNDERLYING HEALTH CONDITION** that can put you at increased risk (for example, a condition that impairs your lung or heart function or weakens your immune system), stay home and away from other people.

# TRAVEL IS FUN Statement on Coronavirus/COVID19

We understand our customers are concerned about the potential for the spread of Coronavirus/COVID19 during your motor-coach travel.

We wanted to share with you what TRAVEL IS FUN TOURS is doing to protect you and allow us to continue providing safe and memorable adventures!

## What TRAVEL IS FUN is doing:

- **Please check our website often to get updates on which trips are running or cancelled, Cancelled trips will be indicated by being lined through – ~~Like This~~. We will also be making calls to inform customers on canceled trips as quickly as we can**
- We are dedicated to reducing any risk of sickness on our motor-coach tours. This includes daily treatment of all likely contact surfaces and restroom space in the coach disinfectant spray and wipes.
- We will be offering the maximum credit that we can for customers cancelling trips due to a suspected exposure or symptoms of coronavirus to protect the other passengers on our trips. Any Trips we cancel will be refunded in full as soon as possible. Please be patient as we are dealing with a large volume of cancellations.
- If a passenger on our tour develops a cough, fever or other signs of exposure they will be asked to wear a surgical mask from our first aid kit to help prevent the spread of germs and viruses.
- We will offer any passengers showing symptoms assistance in visiting an urgent care facility to be assessed.
- We are closely monitoring official CDC (Center for Disease Control, [www.cdc.gov](http://www.cdc.gov)) and other official news outlets in addition to watching other industry leaders to keep our policies fair & effective.
- The US so far is at dramatically lower risk than other countries. Our health care system and infrastructure are the best in the world and will contain this much more effectively.

## What you can do:

- We offer Travel Protection policies for a modest fee through our office, A travel protection policy will cover you for full reimbursement of the cost of your multi-day tour in the event of a valid cancellation due to illness or injury.
- Don't obsess over cable news channels - Check CDC and other reputable information sites for accurate, unbiased information.
- Wash your hands for 20 seconds with soap and use alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- When coughing and sneezing, cover mouth and nose with flexed elbow or tissue – discard tissue immediately into a closed bin.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Bring personal hand sanitizer and wipes with you to all public places.
- Stay home if you have a fever or feel unwell.
