Visit the **Kentucky Derby Museum** & guided tour of **Churchill Downs**. Visit the all-new **Fourth St. Live!** A dining, entertainment & retail experience (lunch on own). Guided (step on guide) city tour of Louisville with the Downtown Highlights, Historic Past & Present. Tour the **Louisville Slugger Factory**. A **Riverboat Luncheon Cruise** on the Ohio River aboard the "**Mary M. Miller**" named for the first female Riverboat Captain. The **Frazier History Museum** with its fascinating exhibits and optional Bourbon tasting featuring three brands (fee applies).

**Day One** – The destination for our first day of travel is **Morrow GA**, just south of **Atlanta**, where we will have one-night at the **Drury Inn**. Drury Inns are offering their guests an incredible array of amenities to include: arrival refreshments, complimentary in-room coffee, deluxe continental breakfast (hot & cold), free long-distance calls (60 minutes per room, per night) also, evening beverages and the **FREE 5:30 KICKBACK** from 5:30 – 7:00 PM. Drury has increased their evening food offerings to always include salad and baked potato bar, nacho bar, snack mix, chips, carrots, celery and dip. There will also be items such as broccoli cheddar soup, macaroni and cheese, breaded chicken strips, boneless chicken wings, and chili-dogs offered on a rotating basis. We will call this our "Drury Dinner". The delicious, very deluxe continental **breakfast** Drury has always offered includes eggs, sausage, self-serve waffle maker, yogurt, fresh fruit, juices, milk & cereal, bagels, biscuits and gravy and more. Every day of this tour our Hotel is a **Drury Inn** with these great amenities included!!

**Day Two, Three & Four** – After our included **Drury** breakfast, today's travels will take us from **Atlanta to Louisville** via **Chattanooga** and **Nashville**. There is a lot of beautiful mountain scenery to enjoy along the way. Today's first rest break is near beautiful Chattanooga TN in the foothills of the Appalachians. Our drive continues along the lovely Tennessee River – crossing it near Lake Nickajack and then driving across the **Appalachian Mountains**. Today's lunch break (on your own) will be in Nashville TN – Music City USA. After lunch, we will continue toward our Louisville destination. (Due to Kentucky state law a small fee charged for alcoholic beverages at the 5:30 Kickback). Each evening in Louisville, we have the **5:30 Kickback** at the **Drury Inn** with complimentary food and soft drinks (minimal fee on beer, wine & mixed drinks). Our first full day in Louisville features a visit to the **Kentucky Derby Museum**. Admission includes two levels of family-friendly interactive exhibits, "The Greatest Race," a 360-degree immersive sound and visual

experience that'll get your heart racing and emotions soaring, Historic Walking Tour of **Churchill Downs** Racetrack, a chance to meet their resident Thoroughbred and miniature horse and access to the Finish Line Gift Shop. For some midday fun, we pay a visit to **4<sup>th</sup> Street Live!** This new Dining, Entertainment and Retail hotspot is a great way to spend a little time. While here you'll find several options for lunch (on your own). Also, in the neighborhood, the **Cathedral of the Assumption** is a beautiful sight to see with its long, vibrant history dating back to the Cathedral's completion in 1852. There is a weekday mass at 12:00, if you are so inclined. After our lunch break, we will pick up our local, professional step-on tour guide. He will provide insight into Downtown Louisville, Past and Present – and the historic areas with many well-preserved mansions and much more. At the end of this full day we return to Drury Inn and evening festivities.



Our second full-day of touring in Louisville is full of great activities as well. Our day will begin with a visit to the **Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory**. This is one of the city's most popular attractions and is housed with their corporate headquarters. The location is well-marked by the World's Biggest Baseball Bat that casually leans against the side of the building. Guests are invited to learn about the Official Bat of Major League Baseball–Louisville Slugger. Today, over 3-million people have enjoyed the museum and factory tour experience at this location. You'll find a lot of fun photo-ops here. Our next experience is a Luncheon **Cruise** aboard the "**Mary M. Miller**". Built in 1985, The Mary M. Miller was named after Louisvillian Mary Millicent Miller, who also happened to be the first woman to ever attain her steamboat captain's license way back in 1884. Originally built in nearby Utica, Indiana, Mary has proudly served in both Kansas city and Savannah, GA. She's back home now and we couldn't be prouder. She is a charming mix of historic river travel and modern conveniences. This is not your typical lunch spot; this cruise will include a delicious **lunch buffet** with a side of culture. You'll sightsee, with informative narration along the **Ohio River**. The riverboat also features live music and a cash-bar for your enjoyment. Our final big adventure in Louisville is a visit to the **Frazier History Museum**. First floor of the museum houses the **Kentucky Bourbon Trail Welcome Center!** Here, Whiskey tasting is offered, with 3 brands, fee applies for tasting.

**Day Six** – After our whirlwind of activities in Louisville, our journey home begins with departure after breakfast. Our final tour night is spent at the **Drury Inn Atlanta Airport** location (with Drury amenities, same as on Day One). Enjoy tonight's **5:30 Kickback** with food, drinks and friends. This will be a nice time to share all you've seen and done with your travel mates, both old and new.

**Day Seven** – After enjoying the breakfast offerings this morning, our tour begins winding down as we return to St. Petersburg, with appropriate stops along the way. Please enjoy the lovely scenery and thank you for choosing **Travel Is Fun Tours!**
