

Our **two-hour dinner cruise** is a wonderful way to unwind from a full travel schedule or a busy day of sightseeing in Savannah. Sit back and relax on board in one of our beautifully appointed ballrooms while our Riverboat slowly glides down the Savannah River. Enjoy a specially prepared buffet style dinner made with the freshest, local ingredients that has something to satisfy everyone's palate!

Day Two – After a nice breakfast at our hotel we will motor back to Old Savannah. Downtown Savannah is full of many interesting sights, filled with dozens of boutiques, shops & restaurants. The Riverfront area is where former Cotton Warehouses, known as Factor's Walk are now being utilized as restaurants, hotels and shops. This beautiful city eloquently displays exquisite ironwork, ancient cobblestones, splendid mansions, and picturesque cottages. **City Market** is known as "The art and Soul of Savannah". Since the early 1700's, City Market has been the commercial and social center of historic Savannah. Located on the original site of the market used by farmers and traders of all kinds to sell their goods and wares, City Market offers the best of what is old and new in Savannah. This charming, open air-marketplace has a wealth of things to do in Savannah whether you come for the entertainment, to shop, dine or just rest your weary feet. A stroll down **Savannah's Riverwalk** is not only pleasing, it's truly serene. Walk along the Savannah River; stop in for a bite at any of 21 restaurants or simply enjoy the scenery as you head towards the adjoining River Street, just a short distance away. On River Street, in the heart of historic

Savannah, you'll find everything from sweets to teddy bears, art galleries and restaurants housed inside restored Cotton Warehouses. The working harbor—filled with ships of all kinds, horse-drawn carriage rides and street performers add to the enticement of this idyllic waterfront locale. Eat, drink, shop and linger; there is much to see and do on River Street - a lovely oasis of shopping, dining, and culture.



While in Savannah today, you will have a full day of **sightseeing** on board the **Historic Old Town Trolley** with **on/off privileges**. For your convenience, the trolley stop is next to the visitor's center and the city has many unique points of interest such as: Savannah's unique park squares, which were built prior to the Civil War, the cobblestone and brick streets, row houses and mansions, beautiful Magnolia trees and Live Oak trees draped in Spanish Moss. Also, be sure to notice many of Savannah's beautiful, **historic Churches**, some may be open for touring. You may want to have lunch (on your own) at either Paula Deen's Lady & Sons or Mrs. Wilkes Dining Room, two very popular local restaurants. Mrs. Wilkes and Mercer House are both at the same trolley stop, and there are many other choices around town too! The **Mercer House** was designed by New York architect John S. Norris for General Hugh W. Mercer, great grandfather of Johnny Mercer

and is well-known from the movie and book "Midnight in the Garden of Good and Evil". For those who enjoy history and exquisite architecture, the Mercer House is a must see. Another type of tour you may want to arrange on your own is a walking tour. There are many interesting things to see within walking distance of drop off point at the visitor's center and walking tours are very popular in Savannah. After dinner on your own we will return to our hotel for a well-earned good night's rest!

<u>Day Three</u> – Again, enjoy the hot breakfast provided at our hotel before our departure back to St. Petersburg. We hope you have found Savannah both charming and unforgettable. Thank you for choosing **Travel Is Fun Tours** for your Savannah Tour.
