

Day One - On our first morning together we will travel directly to the **JC Cruise 4-hour Sightseeing Luncheon** Cruise. You'll see Fort Myers from a different perspective, sailing along the calm Caloosahatchee River, viewing the historic sights - the **Ford and Edison Estates** that formed the roots of Fort Myers. Sailing west towards the Gulf of Mexico on the Intracoastal Waterway, you'll pass beautiful homes, Cape Coral, Shell Point and occasional dolphins swimming along the waterway. Take in the sights from the 2 inside, climate-controlled decks with large windows or from the open 3<sup>rd</sup> deck. You'll enjoy informed narration, **buffet lunch**, music for dancing and cash bars. After this great cruise, we will check in to the **Drury Inn Ft. Myers** for a one-night stay. Drury Inns are offering their guests an incredible array of amenities including: arrival refreshments, complimentary in-room coffee, deluxe continental breakfast (hot & cold), free



long-distance calls (60 minutes per room, per night) also, evening beverages and the **FREE 5:30 KICKBACK!** from 5:30 – 7:00 PM. Drury has increased their evening food offerings to always include salad and baked potato bar, nacho bar, snack mix, chips, carrots, celery and dip. There will also be items such as broccoli cheddar soup, macaroni and cheese, breaded chicken strips, boneless chicken wings, and chili-dogs offered on a rotating basis. Day Two – Today, after enjoying the **hot breakfast buffet** at Drury Inn, we will visit the **Naples Zoo at Caribbean Gardens!** The Naples Zoo began as a personal project of botanist Dr. Henry Nehrling, who purchased the land in 1919 to protect his plant collection. The conversion to a zoo started in 1967, when Col. Lawrence and Nancy Jane Tetzlaff, known as Jungle Larry and Safari Jane, visited the Gardens while looking for somewhere to house their collection of rare animals during the winter. It was opened with the animals in place on September 1, 1969. The 44-acre zoo features a self-guiding trail that winds through a historic botanical garden populated by big-cats, macaws, zebras, black bears, a Florida panther, red ruffed lemurs, honey badgers and more! South American wildlife include a giant anteater and cotton-top tamarins. An exhibit allows visitors to feed giraffes. Visitors can observe natural animal behavior complemented by wildlife footage and graphics during two feature presentations in the Safari Canyon Theater. You'll also experience keeper talks, alligator feedings and Snakes Alive Presentations. A 20-minute boat cruise offers views of monkeys, brown and ring-tailed lemurs and gibbons roaming freely on island habitats. There are places to enjoy lunch (on your own) at the Naples Zoo today. After our fantastic zoo adventure, we will depart Naples and head north, back to our homes, thank you for choosing **Travel Is Fun Tours!**
