**Day One** – On our first day together we will travel directly (with appropriate stops) to **Fort Lauderdale**. Our first exciting activity is the **New River Boat Tour!** There's a good reason why Fort Lauderdale is known as the Venice of America and the Yachting Capital of the World. The city's 300 miles of navigable waterways-the Intracoastal Waterway, the New River and the canals that cut away from these liquid highways like side streets veering off a main thoroughfare-create a lacy honeycombed grid where boats replace cars as the means of transportation. The narrated 90-minute boat tour will feature views of the homes and yachts of the Rich and Famous as well as a lot of beautiful scenery. A dinner stop (on

your own) will be made, perhaps at brand new, nearby **Dania Pointe** with many shopping and dining options. We will check into our hotel for a two-night stay, the **SPRINGHILL SUITES BY MARRIOTT** in Fort Lauderdale. This all-suites hotel features larger hotel rooms with WIFI, refrigerators, microwaves and an included **Grab n Go Breakfast** is offered in the lobby **each morning**.

**Day Two** – Our first activity today is a tour of **Vizcaya Museum & Gardens** – a breathtaking Gilded Age Estate on Biscayne Bay. This is formerly the winter residence of American businessman James Deering, the European-inspired estate features 34 rooms lavishly furnished with art and furnishings spanning 2000 years. Hedges and walls divide the estate into many small gardens, similar to 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup>-century Italy & France. The design features fountains, sculptures and hidden gardens. At the foot of the steps leading to Biscayne Bay, an unusual, sculptured barge serves as a breakwater. Followed by a visit to **Bayside Marketplace** in downtown Miami with time to browse and have lunch on your own. Next, we'll have a driving tour starting in **South Beach – the famous Art-Deco District – where it all began!** The touring continues on A1A where we'll pass through Miami Beach, Surfside, Bal Harbor, North Miami Beach, Sunny Isles, Hallandale Beach, Hollywood Beach and more! A dinner stop (on your own) will be made as well.

**Day Three** – Our final day together includes a visit to **Everglades Holiday Park** for an **Airboat Tour** through the Everglades followed by a **Live Alligator Presentation** with the **Gator Boys Alligator Rescue Team!** With miles of wetlands before you, you'll journey deep into the Everglades, zipping across the "River of Grass" at top speeds, with an expert tour guide leading the way. This fleet of **airboats** are spacious, safe, and offer comfort and covered protection from all weather conditions. Lock eyes with an American alligator and snap amazing pictures as you come face-to-face with some of the Everglades most unusual and exciting animals.
