Day Three – Enjoy a continental **breakfast** before departing for a **full-day Guided tour of Washington D.C.** Some of the awe-inspiring sights on this fantastic tour will include the **US Capitol, the White House, the National Archives, Embassy Row and Georgetown.** During the day, you will see the **Washington Monument, Lincoln Memorial and several War Memorials.** This evening, enjoy **Dinner** at a local restaurant before continuing to the **Guided Memorial and Monuments Tour.** After this busy day of touring we return to our hotel for some well-earned rest.

Day Four – Begin your day with continental **breakfast** at the hotel. Today's Guided Tour includes such poignant and inspirational sights as **Arlington National Cemetery, including the Tomb of the Unknowns and Kennedy Graves as well as the Iwo Jima Memorial.** You'll also enjoy a visit to the **Smithsonian Institution.** Later, you'll enjoy **Dinner with entertainment** before returning to your hotel for the night.

Day Five – Start your last day in our Nation’s Capital with continental **breakfast** at the hotel. This morning you will head to **George Washington’s Mount Vernon Estate & Garden**. The home was originally built in 1735 by George Washington’s father, Augustine along the Potomac River. In 1754, George Washington began residing at Mount Vernon, a 3,000-acre estate and a house that likely approximated 3,500 square feet. By his death in 1799, Washington’s Mount Vernon consisted of about 7,600 acres and an almost 11,000 square foot mansion. Next, you’ll head to the **brand-new**, 430,000 square foot **MUSEUM OF THE BIBLE**. Discover the history, narrative and impact the Bible has played in our world’s history. From the 40-foot tall bronze doors at the museum’s entrance, to the roof-top garden, explore over six floors of exhibits that span the time, space and cultures of the Bible. With over 40,000 items, the Museum’s collection contains some of the oldest and most important biblical artifacts and documents in human history. Tonight, enjoy a relaxing **dinner** and restful night at your hotel.

Day Six - Today, after enjoying a continental **Breakfast** it’s time to head back toward Florida and our home for tonight is the **Best Western Plus in Santee SC**, again. Same amenities as described in Day One. Tonight’s **dinner** suggestion is a Travel is Fun favorite - Captain’s Quarters, adjacent to the hotel (meal on your own). There are also other nearby restaurants to choose from, including Shoney’s.

Day Seven - After enjoying our final delicious breakfast of this tour, we will resume our travel back to St. Petersburg.
