Includes: A special getaway to charming Amelia Island with 2 nts. at the **Hampton** Inn Amelia Island at Fernandina Beach Historic Harbor Front Hotel with adjacent views of Cumberland Island and an included, **guided historic area tour** and the Cumberland Coastal Boat Tour. Delicious hot breakfast is included at our hotel each morning. Driving tour along Atlantic Ocean featuring many historic points of interest, then a driving tour with a brief stop in St. Augustine.

Day One – On our first day together we will travel directly (with appropriate stops) to Amelia Island/Fernandina Beach. we will check in to our hotel for the next two nights - Hampton Inn Amelia Island at Fernandina Beach Historic Harbor Front Hotel. Hampton on the House breakfast (featuring both hot and cold items) is included each morning. Our hotel is in an ideal location only one block from the cruise docks where you may enjoy lovely views of Cumberland Island. This is a very lovely hotel in a terrific location, and with our mid-afternoon arrival you'll have plenty of free time to explore. There are many shops and restaurants within walking distance of the hotel and this evening is yours to explore and dine as you wish! There are several great dinner choices nearby including **The Marina**, about 1 block away. For an elegant evening, try Brett's Waterway Café which extends out over the water, Timoti's Seafood Shack is another favorite in town as well as the nearby Salty Pelican. Many more choices within walking distance too!

Day Two - Enjoy your Hampton on the House breakfast this morning, next, we will depart for our fully narrated, guided tour aboard the motorcoach, with a terrific, local step-on guide. We will explore the areas of historic Fernandina Beach and the Old Town area. This tour gives a great overview of the area as you will tour along the beautiful and historic streets of Fernandina Beach and Old Town Fernandina. This tour will take you around the Historic District to view the beautiful homes and Victorian buildings while your experienced tour quide will provide a lovely narrative of the local history. Then, the tour moves on to the north end of the island to Old Town Fernandina, originally platted by the Spanish in 1811. Some historic points of interest include Plaza Fort San Carlos, the Pippi



Longstocking House and Ladies Street, just to name a few. Relax and enjoy the variety of sights this tour offers. Then, later today, we have an included boat tour at 2:00 PM, but midday is

yours to enjoy exploring great points of interest and have lunch on your own in Fernandina Beach. Again, this is a walking community with much to see including the Amelia Island Museum of History (small fee applies). The group will meet up again this afternoon at Amelia **River Cruises** to enjoy the included **Cumberland Coastal Boat Tour -** a narrated history & wildlife sightseeing cruise along the shorelines of Amelia and Cumberland Islands. Enjoy the fresh air and salty breeze as you look for playful dolphins while the entertaining captain tells you about the landmarks & history of Amelia Island before we cross the Georgia state line towards Cumberland Island. Discover what life was like in past centuries for the residents of Cumberland Island as the crew continue to share the intriguing history of this backyard Paradise. Marvel at beautiful coastlines, salt marshes, and maritime forests while learning about the wildlife, from wild horses and sea turtles to deer and wild turkeys. This evening, after the scenic boat tour you'll have time to explore the diverse world of dinner options (on your own) near our Hampton Inn Amelia Island-Historic Harbor Front hotel, conveniently located in the historic downtown district within walking distance of over 25 restaurants. Delicious seafood, local ethnic "treasures," historic eateries and convenient, familiar chains, which are sure to satisfy. Then, enjoy a good night's rest in Hampton Inn's comfy beds.

Day Three - Enjoy your included Hampton on the House breakfast this morning before departing for home through our beautiful state. We will travel south through Amelia Island and along the Atlantic Coast as well as crossing the St. John's River. We will be passing through communities such as American Beach. American Beach is located on Amelia Island, just north of Jacksonville, Florida between two upscale sentinels -- the Ritz-Carlton Amelia Island and Amelia Island Plantation. Founded in 1935 by Abraham Lincoln Lewis, American Beach was created as a vacation haven for African Americans, for whom access to other resorts was denied in the days before desegregation. In the early 1930s, A.L. Lewis, Florida's first black millionaire and president of Afro-American Insurance Company in Jacksonville, bought 200 acres of prime Florida beachfront so his employees could enjoy the Florida shore. Continuing south, we'll pass through - Big Talbot Island, Little Talbot Island, then, keep your eyes open for the large Navy ships and freighters in Mayport, then, we continue south through Jacksonville Beach, Ponte Vedra Beach, and Vilano Beach. Next, we arrive at St. Augustine where we will have a short driving tour with a rest break at a local point-of-interest. We continue toward home with a lunch stop on your own in Palatka FL just after crossing the St. Johns River.
