

Today will begin with a visit to nearby **Sugarlands Visitor Center** in Smoky Mtn. National Park. You will learn about the park's plants and animals with Natural History exhibits. Enjoy Ranger-led programs conducted seasonally. Peruse the Park bookstore and shop while here. Next, we will visit neighboring **Gatlinburg** where you may

want to go up the mountain on the chairlift for a bird's eye view, great for photo-taking. Or give the **Pedestrian SkyBridge** a try, it is 700' long, 150' high, and the center portion of the bridge is glass and will provide awesome views! You'll find breathtaking mountain views <u>all</u> around, a great location to view the autumn leaves. There is plenty to enjoy as you browse your way through town & enjoy lunch (on your own). Don't miss the Moonshine shops with sampling usually available. We should have time to return to the hotel to freshen up for tonight's Dinner Show at **Hatfield & McCoy Dinner Feud!** This evening, we'll see your favorite feuding families in the Dolly Parton Production of the **Hatfield and McCoy Dinner Show!** Just a few of the elements found in the Hatfield and McCoy show include singing, dancing, acting, aerial stunts, and rope tricks. There is so much to see! You'll feast upon an all-you-can-eat buffet-style dinner with options such as fried chicken, pulled pork shoulder, 'smashed mashed taters', and buttery corn on the cob and dessert too.
