The Pirate's House first opened as an Inn for Seafarers, and fast became a rendezvous for blood-thirsty pirates and sailors from the Seven Seas. At the Pirate's House, our most precious treasure is our food. After our lunch, we will visit and tour the **Mercer-Williams House**, designed by New York architect John S. Norris for General Hugh W. Mercer, great-grandfather of Johnny Mercer. Featured in the Novel & Film "Midnight in the **Garden of Good & Evil"**, a true story, you'll enjoy seeing the home & gardens with your own eyes! Construction began in 1860 and you'll learn much more about this fabulous, historic home during your visit. Our guided tour will conclude at **Forsyth Park** with the opportunity to take photos at the iconic Forsyth Park Fountain. After our fun and informative day of touring Savannah, we'll return to Drury Inn to enjoy food and drinks at the daily 5:30 Kickback!

<u>Day Three</u> – After our included, hot breakfast buffet at Drury Inn, our Savannah touring continues as we visit the **Ships of the Maritime Museum**.
